

General Information:

Thank you for your interest in our Chihuahuas!

We breed to show, so we usually keep any pups that look promising for the show ring. It is generally much easier to get a male than a female. We can usually tell within 8 - 12 weeks if a pup will be staying here with us as a show prospect, but sometimes it may take longer than that, especially if we are waiting on the pup to grow or for testicles to descend.

We do not place pet puppies "sight-unseen". Interested parties should be able to pick up their new puppy in person in order to ensure that the temperament, health and other characteristics of the puppy are satisfactory to the new owner. On occasion we are willing to travel (within reason and according to our schedule) to meet new owners.

Our pet puppies are usually priced at \$750-\$1800 depending on each puppy. A non-refundable deposit is required to hold a puppy. Puppies priced under \$1,000 will require a \$250 deposit, and those priced above \$1,000 will require a \$500 deposit. Please make sure that you want the puppy before placing a deposit. We will not hold a puppy without a deposit – no exceptions! We accept Paypal (for deposit only + add 3.5% fee), Postal Money Orders, and Cashier's Bank Checks. The total remaining balance is to be paid 1 week prior to the shipping date.

Payment plans are available in some instances. Please contact us to discuss details. Note: Please contact us early to discuss payment arrangements, not once the puppy is ready to go home. Our puppies do not leave us until they are paid for in full!

All of our dogs are AKC registered and most of the time they have at least one AKC champion parent. Our "pet" puppies are sold with limited AKC registration and a spay/neuter agreement – NO EXCEPTIONS! Please note that just because a puppy is available as a pet does not necessarily indicate that the puppy is substandard! It can simply be because the puppy will be too small, or has too sweet of an attitude for the ring! Not every puppy is destined for the show ring, but every puppy can definitely be loved!

We occasionally place adult dogs who have retired from our breeding program to special homes for a small adoption fee. These adults have been spayed/neutered and have had a recent dental/cleaning.

We will also consider selling show prospects to serious exhibitors who are willing and able to campaign it successfully.

All of our dogs are sold or placed with AKC papers and a health guarantee. Every puppy and dog is current on vaccinations and worming for their age. All puppies are sold with a 12 month guarantee against life threatening genetic defects.

Typically our puppies can leave us around 12 weeks of age. We may require them to stay longer if they are smaller or if they are not eating the way we would like them to be. Our puppies will come current on shots and worming according to their age, and started on litterbox training.

We firmly believe that there are too many unwanted and poorly bred puppies born into this world and we will not knowingly add to the problem. If we sell a puppy on a spay/neuter agreement, it is not intended to be bred! We contractually require that ALL pet puppies be spayed or neutered within 6 months of purchase, and AKC papers will be withheld until proof of sterilization is provided from a licensed veterinarian.

When contacting us, please do not send “one-liner” emails. We require that you fill out our puppy application, or you can summarize by telling us your name, where you are from, why you are interested in one of our puppies (pet/breeding/show), a little about you and your household (how many other dogs, children), and what you are looking for in a puppy (male/female, smooth/long coat). This information can easily be completed on our application found on our links page. Please fill in the information and send to us in an email.

Note on Contract Information:

Our contracts are different for each puppy sold, based on whether the puppy is being sold as a pet or as a show or breeding prospect. All of our contracts do include vaccination and worming records, surgery records (if applicable), and any other health related items. We do require first right of refusal if at any time the new owner cannot care for the dog and also must give written permission to the owner before the dog can be rehomed. We also require that neither the dog nor any of its offspring be sold or given to puppy dealers, laboratories, brokers, pet shops, puppy mills, rescue groups, shelters, etc. If a dog is being sold as a show prospect, we contractually require that it be shown when it is of proper age for show.
